Chiefs Report
June/July 2022

The month of June was almost the same as last year with 60 calls for service but still 33% higher than our 3-year average (61 calls in 2021, and an average of 40 in June over the last three years). We did not receive or give mutual aid this month. Our priority response time was average at 5:37 and we had six BLS transports.

The month of July was also the same as last year with 54 calls for service and 13% over our 3-year average (54 calls in 2021, and an average of 47 in July over the last three years). We did not receive or give mutual aid this month. Our priority response time was excellent at 5:09 and we had two BLS transports.

South Pierce fire academy is in full swing with two Riverside personnel attending. We have been working on recruiting new volunteers and should have five people to add to the Brown's Point Fire academy which starts August 4th. Michael Cramer and Doug Thor worked together to teach driver and pump operations to the newly graduated recruits from Buckley and Browns Point. They are now working on their skills to get checked off as drivers. Chief Thirkield taught Firefighter II to 16 people from Riverside, Browns Point, South Pierce and JBLM. They all successfully passed their IFSAC practical and are awaiting their written test results.

Operations has gone through some major transitions as we are sad and proud to announce that BC Michael Cramer is moving on to South King Fire and Rescue. His last shift was mid-July so we were working heavily on making sure the transition is smooth. Michael will be greatly missed as he was an incredible employee and person.

The past two months we have completed the annual pump test and cosmetic repairs on E74 from two prior incidents, new brakes front and rear on U741, extensive mechanical repairs on U742 and the annual maintenance on Air 74. Station projects have included replacing the station air compressor, sleeping dorm A/C unit replacement, new blinds in the back office, new lights for the bathrooms, and a 6-camera security and alerting system.

The Administrative Division spend most of the last couple months ensuring that the transition in full-time staff has minimal impacts on operations and service. An application process and test was put together with the help of officers from Browns Point, West Pierce and Buckley fire.

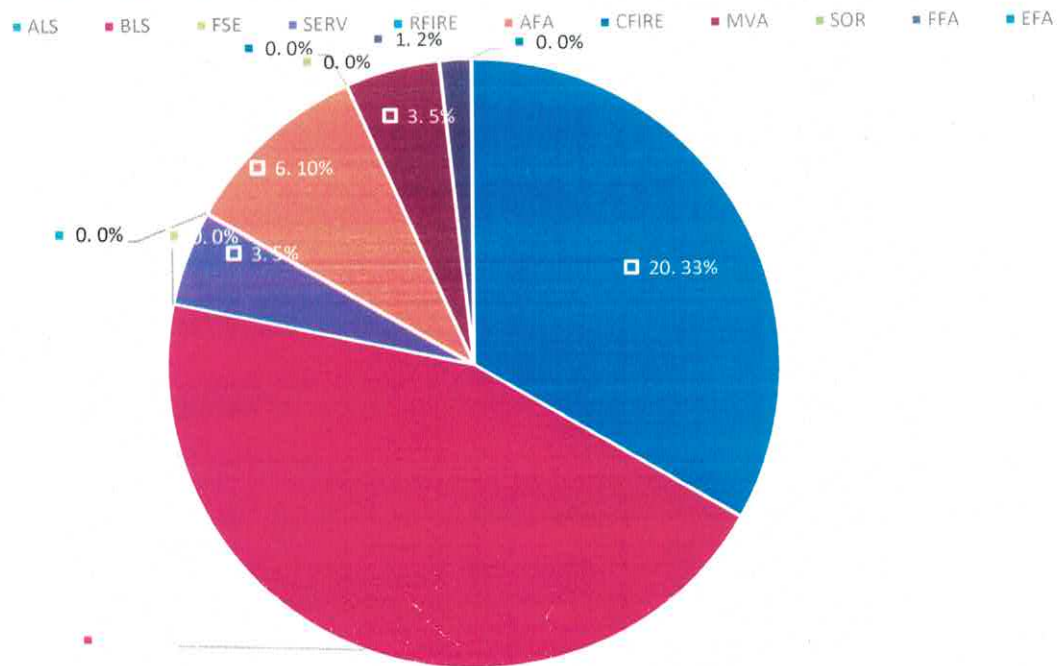

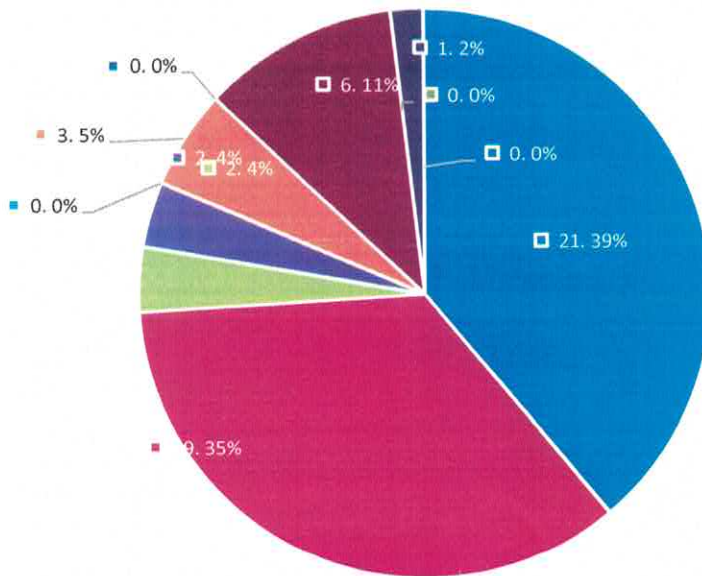

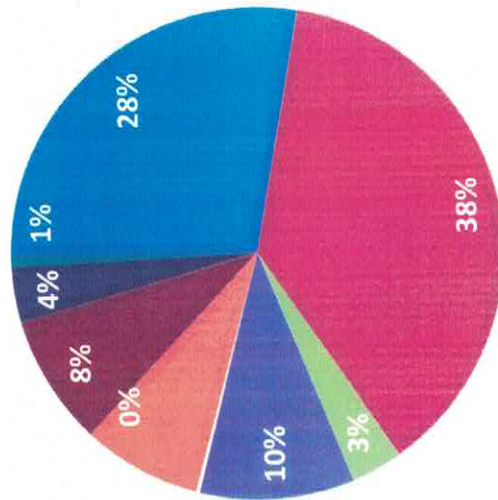
