Chiefs Report January 2022

The month of January had higher call volumes than in the past but similar when compared to last year with 60 calls for service (January 2021, 2020, and 2019 had 58, 41, and 32 respectively). We did not receive or provide mutual aid this month. Our priority response time was 5:08 and we had three BLS transports.

The Operations division has been making sure station equipment and apparatus are in ideal functioning condition. In January we sent in three generators including the hydraulic generator for repairs and preventative maintenance. U743 has also been sent in for preventative maintenance, is running well, and the recruits are actively using it for transportation to and from academy. U742 visited the mechanic as well and is now ready for Maniago to start duty shifts. FireComm has Maniago's information and is in the process of updating his tablet to include CAD. At this time, we are beginning annual reviews for all members, with Chief Cramer conducting all reviews for the team leads, and the team leads reviewing all other members in turn.

New member training continues to be time intensive. Both academies have started, with seven candidates attending in Buckley and 10 in Brown's Point. Chief Cramer is the main contact for academy and has been attending weekend academy for Brown's Point, with Captain Thor attending weekends at Buckley. Supraglottic Airway and Stop the Bleed classes have been planned for February with instructor Kaylee Garrett of Buckley Fire. We once again have use of the Tacoma Training Facility for drills. We continue to work through staffing issues until training and academy can be completed for these new candidates.


The Administrative Division has made several steps forward with Cramer promoted to Battalion Chief and Thor being promoted to Captain. The state audit is almost finished at this point, and files/processes at the Department have been updated for 2022. New member paperwork is being carefully tracked and nearing completion. Chief Cramer will be cross trained on important admin items for continuity of services. Chief Thirkield is on the EMS Council representing BLS agencies for the PC Fire Chief's Association and is currently working on analyzing private ambulance usage by local BLS agencies.

The focus of February will be completing the state audit, creating policies for our new EMT-only candidates, updating old policies, and focusing on our academy candidates.
